PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Ottawa Group Psychotherapy Training Institute (**OGPTI**) provides advanced training in group psychotherapy in accordance with the guidelines established by the Canadian Group Psychotherapy Association (CGPA). OGPTI is accredited by the American Group Psychotherapy Association as a training program in group therapy.

The Training Program focuses on providing 30 hours of didactic instruction which is part of the requirement to be a full member of CGPA. Emphasis is placed on training in interpersonal, cognitive and psychodynamic models.

The **OGPTI** is committed to providing continuing education workshops for practicing group psychotherapists, and facilitating research efforts in group psychotherapy.
